Scene 2 ____ Abduction

Guide: Some of the most exciting and influential days of our lives are those of the middle school and high school years. The friendships and relationships we had then are the ones that make us into the individuals that we are today or will be tomorrow. Kate and Wendy are great role models for their younger sisters. They also are obviously making a difference on this gymnastics team. The Bible says in 1 Peter 3: 15 (NIV) "But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect." It's such a tragedy that Kelly and her family were killed on the highway. It's wonderful though that through the story of her death, Becca has seen her need for Jesus Christ. I just wish that Abby had been that receptive.

Well, the afternoon at the gym is over, and it's off to the movies and an evening of fun! Let's go see what happens!

(People are coming and going while the scene unfolds. Standing in line at the concessions stand and then leaving with candy, popcorn, and drinks. In the center of the lobby area Wendy and Kate are standing with their boyfriends Justin and Taylor along with Becca and Abby. They are laughing and talking as the group enters.)

Taylor: So Becca, is it true you got down on your knees right there on the gym floor and asked Jesus into your heart....in front of God and everybody?

Becca: Sure did Taylor. I still can't believe that I did it. You know how easily I get embarrassed.

Abby: Yeah, you made a fool of yourself all right.

Justin: No kidding.

Becca (ignoring Abby) But when I heard that Kelly, who had none of the great stuff in life that I've had, found the one thing that I didn't have...that really made me stop and think.

Taylor: All I got to say is 'way to go little sis'! (Gives her a high five) And everybody says that middle schoolers are stupid. That is the most important decision you will ever make. That's awesome!

Abby: Yeah, whatever! We've got some guys to meet.

Wendy: What guys?

Abby: (Points to guys across the room) those two guys playing video games. They don't know it yet but we're the answer to their prayers.

(Group laughs as Abby and Becca turn to walk over to guys)

Wendy: You two behave, and don't do anything I wouldn't do.

Kate: Hang on a second Becca, When is your movie over?

Becca: I think around 9:30.

Kate: OK, we'll meet you two right here at 9:30.

Wendy: And ya'll, don't hang out in the parking lot. There's all kind of stuff going on out there.

Abby: (talking sarcastically over her shoulder) Yes Mother! We'd so love to hang around and chat but we've got places to go and guys to meet. See ya! Oh wait. Can I get your keys to the car? I left my purse in the back seat.

Wendy: Here. (Hands her the keys) Be careful. Do you remember where we parked?

Abby: Duh, it was only 5 minutes ago!

Kate: Let us go with you.

Justin: No Kate, I'll escort these lovely ladies to the car (offers his arms to the girls)

Becca: We'll be right back. (Becca and Abby leave with Justin)

Justin: Taylor, just get me something to eat, I'm starvin'.

Taylor: Now you're talking! (Turns to the clerk) I want a hot dog with cheese, nachos with cheese, cheese fries and, you got any cheezits? What would you girls like? Bean sprouts, sushi and bottled water?

Wendy: No way! I'll have jumbo popcorn with lots of butter. Easy on the popcorn!

Kate: And some M & M's.

Taylor: What do you want to drink?

Wendy: Diet Coke of course.

Taylor: Cool.

Wendy: Did you ask Justin about his relationship with Christ?

Taylor: Sure did, and he ain't got one.

Wendy: What did he say?

Taylor: He said he knows that one day he'll need religion, but not now.

Wendy: It's not about religion, Taylor.

Taylor: I know that, and you know that, but Justin doesn't know that. He couldn't get it through his thick skull that Christianity is a relationship – a relationship with Jesus.

Wendy: What if something happens to him?

Taylor: I know, I know. But I can't make this decision for him. He's gotta want to turn his life over to Jesus. He thinks he's gonna live to be a hundred.

Wendy: Well, I hope he does, at least that'll give us more time to win him to Christ.

[Off stage a loud scream is heard.]

[Two students run into the theater]

Billy: Somebody call the cops! Some guy was just stabbed in the parking lot and two girls were just thrown in the back of a white van!

Kate: Oh no! Where's Justin, Becca and Abby? They haven't come back yet. What did the girls look like?

Billy: I don't know for sure, but one of them had on a yellow shirt.

Officer: (runs from inside the theater and around the corner talking into a police radio) Signal 38 Two girls abducted. 1515 South Main Street. Send Units ASAP! Need an ambulance too, we got one man stabbed.

Everyone in the lobby runs outside of the theater except for the workers.
