SCENE 2

(Room is divided into two scenes with a wall constructed in the middle so that guests can see both sides of the room. Several youth are sitting around a card table playing quarters.)

Person 2: My turn.

(Lights go out on the left side of Scene 2. Lights come up on the right side)

Natalie: One, two, three, four, so I'm green now.

Person 1: All right Chris, where is the shortest verse in the Bible found?

Chris: I don't know that one.

Natalie: Hey, I think I know that one, isn't it John: 11:35?

Person 1: Yeah that's right.

Natalie: Alright, you know Chris, I am really enjoying Fifth Quarter, thanks for asking me.

Chris: I'm glad you came Natalie, I'm also glad you came to Sunday School and Bible Study. Do you mind if I ask a personal question?

Natalie: No, go ahead.

Chris: Have you ever asked Jesus into your Heart?

Natalie: Chris, is that really necessary, I mean, I go to church every Sunday, I don't drink or anything, isn't that worth something?
