Scene Four- Cafe with outdoor sidewalk seating

Setting: Sidewalk café. A car has just jumped the curb and run into the table where the Endicotts were seated. Carol, Abby, Sarah and a waiter have fatal injuries. Jason was injured as well and is unconscious. Lily was in the restroom when the accident took place. The driver and passengers of the car are frantic but more concerned about getting in trouble with their parents than the actual victims. People are screaming and running. A few people are moving towards the victims to see if they can help. There is total chaos.

LAUREN (jumps out of car frantically): What did I do?! I don't know how this happened? Oh, my God, these people are really hurt! Somebody call 911!

Passengers jump out as well. They are in hysterics and crying.

PASSENGER #1: Oh, this is bad! I've never seen anything like this! (Begins to call parents on cell phone.)

PASSENGER #2: There's so much blood! What are we going to do? Can anyone help these people?

PASSENGER #3 is crying loudly and trying to use her cell phone.

LAUREN: My dad is going to kill me! What have I done?

STORE OWNER (runs up to driver and passengers.): We've called 911. Are any of you hurt?

LAUREN (extremely upset and disoriented): What have I done? What have I done? I was just reaching for my cell phone and the next thing I know I was on the sidewalk. Look at all those people I hurt! Somebody needs to help them!

Lily comes out of the bathroom and sees the chaos. She doesn't know what has happened but then she sees the car sitting where her table was.

LILY (screaming): MOM!! (She begins running toward her family.) MOM!!

A waiter sees Lily and grabs her to try to keep her away from the accident scene.

LILY: Let me go! My mom is hurt! I have to help her!

WAITER: Just stay with me right now. There is glass all over the place. Your mom won't want you to get hurt. Some people are helping her now and everything will be all right.

VARIOUS PATRONS: "These people need help!" "Does anyone know CPR?" "I don't feel a pulse!" "There are some people trapped under this car!" "Did someone call 911?" "We need to get this car off these people!"

Driver and passengers are continuing to cry loudly and although they are concerned for the injured people, they are even more concerned about how their parents will react to what has happened and how it will affect their lives. The passengers may try to comfort the driver with lines like, "It's going to be alright." "Your parents will understand." "It was just an accident." Passengers are also continuing to use their cell phones to try to call friends or family. They may be talking and telling details of the accident.

Flashing lights of an off-scene police car are seen. Police officer runs in from one side of the scene and begins talking to the store owner.

OFFICER (to crowd): Can someone tell me what happened?

LAUREN: It's all my fault! I don't know what happened. I lost control and the next thing I knew I was on the sidewalk! My parents are never going to let me drive again! Please, help these people! Help them!

OFFICER: What caused you to lose control?

LAUREN: My cell phone was ringing and I was trying to reach my purse to answer it.

Siren blast is heard behind the tour group and 2-3 paramedics/fire rescue people break through the tour group and into

the scene. Police officer steps forward to meet paramedics.

PARAMEDIC: What happened here?

OFFICER: It appears that this girl lost control of her car while she was reaching for her cell phone. The car swerved and ended up hitting a table full of people on the sidewalk here. It looks like we have some pretty serious injuries here. There are two people underneath the car and they aren't moving. The waiter was struck and hit the windshield of the car and the fourth victim is over there with severe head trauma.

OFFICER: Everyone get back. We need some room for the paramedics to work. Back up!
